

- This controller is rated IP20; avoid the sun and moisture.
- Avoid using controller in areas where extreme hot, cold, dust, or humidity exist.
- This controller is suitable for indoor, dry locations only.
- Always be sure to mount this controller in an area with proper ventilation to avoid overheating.

INSTALLING WALL MOUNT CONTROLLER (SEE FIGURE 1):

This controller is battery operated and contains a CR2032 battery.

This controller requires a Radio Frequency receiver for operation (REC-5A-4Z or REC-5A-4Z-WiFi sold separately).

- 1. Determine desired location of controller. Cut a hole approximately 1-3/4" wide x 2-5/8" high.
- 2. Pull dial knob off of the front of the controller followed by the plastic washer underneath.
- 3. At the base of the controller, there is a slot where the faceplate meets the mounting plate. Insert a flathead screwdriver into the slot to pop the two pieces apart.
- 4. Set the mounting plate into the 1-3/4" x 2-5/8" cut hole.
- 5. Secure mounting plate to mounting surface with appropriate screws on both the top and bottom of the controller. (Controller includes two #8-32 screws for optional single-gang switch j-box mounting; j-box not included)
- 6. The battery is exposed once the wall mount is open. Be sure to remove the plastic safety tab to ensure operation once fixture is fully installed.
- 7. Set faceplate cover over installed mounting plate and snap into place.
- 8. Replace the plastic washer followed by the dial knob on front of faceplate.



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




SYNCING CONTROLLER TO RECEIVER (SEE FIGURES 2 & 3):

This controller requires a Radio Frequency receiver for operation (REC-5A-4Z or REC-5A-4Z-WiFi sold separately).


- Press the dial knob on the controller once to turn on power to the controller.
- 2. Press the "Learning Key" on the receiver.
- 3. Turn the dial knob on the controller to activate controller.
- 4. Once successfully synced, the connected light source will blink.
- Repeat steps 2-3 when syncing multiple receivers to a single controller.
- 6. Press and hold the "Learning Key" to clear out saved sync data when wanting to reset scenes or zones.



OPERATING CONTROLLER (SEE FIGURE 3):

This controller is battery operated and contains a CR2032 battery.

- 1. Press the dial knob for On/Off power control.
- 2. Turn the dial knob to the right to increase brightness 1-100%.
- 3. Turn the dial knob to the left to decrease brightness 100-1%.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE:

- 1. For cleaning, use a soft, dry or damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasives.
- 2. This controller is battery operated and includes a CR2032 battery. If swallowed, it could cause severe injury or death. Seek medical attention immediately. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Remove exhausted batteries from the product; Please dispose of batteries properly. Do not dispose of batteries in fire; Batteries may explode or leak.
