Installation Instructions:

- **1.)** Uninstall previous light fixture and components. Remove lamp and strip body of any existing wires and components.
- 2.) Bend quarter-turn bracket so that channel covers are fully and tightly covered. Follow 4' and 8' spacing distance for quarter-turn bracket placement.

8' quarter-turn bracket placement




3.) Install the 2 provided quarter-turn bracket QTB S to each end of the luminaire. Secure to the sides of the luminaire's housing with 4 self-tapping Tek screws #8-32. Note: Drill size = 27.




4.) Install 2 prewired lamp sockets onto one end of the RS Series Base Plate at the slots provided. Connect the Line/Black wire (L) from one lamp socket to the Line/Black wire (L) of the nearby socket, and the Neutral/White wire (N) from one socket to the Neutral/White wire (N) to the nearby socket, as illustrated below. Then, install 2 un-wired lamp holders to the slots on other end of the Base Plate.


Note: Push sockets in until fully fastened. Mark the end with pre-wired sockets for lamps installation (step 7).



5.) Connecting wires from the lamp sockets to power source accordingly



6.) Attach the Base Plate to the luminaire housing by inserting and tightening the 4 QRT Turn Mounting Clips onto the QTB S quarter-turn brackets at the slots provided.



- 7.) Install the LED tube lamps to the lamp sockets.

 The lamps are powered at one end only. Install the lamps with the powered end to the pre-wired sockets.
- **8.)** Apply the 2 labels provided to the Back Plate surface where visible during normal maintenance and relamping.
