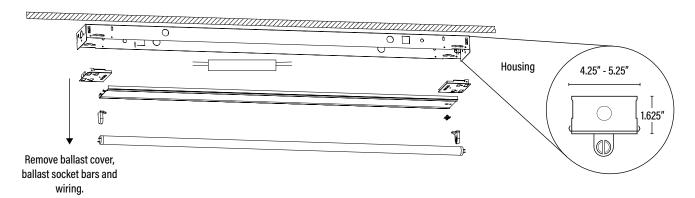
THE KITS HAVE BEEN TESTED, FULLY AND PROPERLY MOUNTED IN A FIXTURE AS SIMILAR AS POSSIBLE TO THE KIT'S INTENDED USE. THE UNIVERSAL DESIGN FITS MOST 4,25" TO 5,25" WIDE T8/T12 FLUORESCENT STRIPS.

INSTALLATION STEPS:

- 1. Shut off power to existing fixture. Disconnect the black and the white power supply wire (and ground wire if equipped) to existing ballast.
- 2. Remove the original lamps from the existing fixture. (Recycle lamps according to state specific recycling guidelines.)
- 3. Remove ballast cover, ballast, socket-bars and wiring. (Fig. 1)

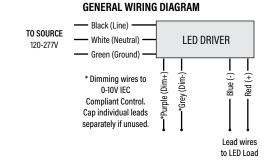

INSTALLATION STEPS (cont'd):

- 4. Install retrofit brackets using screws. (Fig. 2)
- 5. Make electrical connections per wiring diagram.
- 6. Install LED Retrofit Assembly.
- 7. Install lens After installation check to make sure the lens is completely secure, snapped inside the entire length of the lamp body and fitted under the end cap. Gently pull down on the lens to ensure it does not shift.
- 8. Restore power to fixture. (Fig. 3)

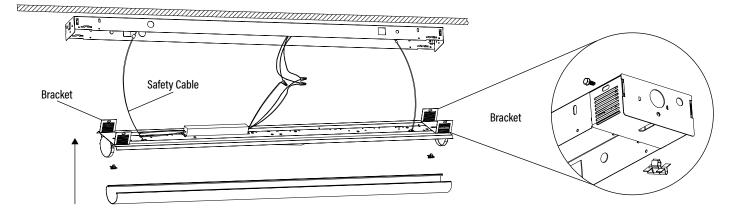

FIELD ADJUSTABLE WATTAGE & CCT (Fig. 4)

The end user may adjust the color temperature and lumen output, respectively, by the two slide switches integrated into the side of the fixture. Each switch has 3 options (left, middle and right), each position corresponds to 1 of 3 color temperatures (Warm White, Cool White, and Sky-Brite®) and 1 of 3 wattages, which can be adjusted to the desired combination.

Default Settings for 55594: 40W, 5000K Default Settings for 55597: 75W, 5000K

- 1. Switches are located on the LED Module driver box.
- **2.** Select a wattage and color temperature by sliding switch left or right respectively to the desired value.
