Description

Coil-Cure Liquid is a powerful non-abrasive disinfectant cleaner for HVAC systems. It is EPA registered to destroy bacteria, fungi and viruses, making it a safe and effective way to clean coils and drain pans. Coil-Cure Liquid is an easy-to-use one step no rinse disinfectant cleaner that leaves no residue, making it an excellent choice for AC units. Coil-Cure has been added to the EPA list N as an EPA Registered disinfectant with emerging viral pathogens AND human coronavirus claims for use against SARS-CoV-2.

Directions for Use:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Before use in federally inspected meat and poultry food processing plants and dairies, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected.

DISINFECTION/VIRUCIDAL*/FUNGICIDAL/MOLD & MILDEW CONTROL DIRECTIONS: Apply this product undiluted to hard, nonporous surfaces, thoroughly wetting the surfaces with a sprayer including HVAC coils and drain pans. Treated surfaces must remain visibly wet for 10 minutes. For Influenza Virus Type A and Human Coronavirus and SARS-Cov-2, treated surfaces must remain visibly wet for 1 minute. Wipe dry with a cloth, sponge or mop or allow to air dry. For visibly soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Spray 6-8 inches from surface using the quart sprayer. Avoid breathing spray. Rinse all surfaces that come in contact with food, such as countertops, appliances, tables and stovetops with potable water before reuse. Do not use on utensils, glassware and dishes.

For mold and mildew: Repeat treatment every 7 days or more often if new growth appears. Effective as a mold and mildew inhibitor in HVAC systems.

To Clean and Deodorize: Apply undiluted to hard, non-porous, HVAC coil and drain pan surfaces with a sprayer. Wipe or allow to air dry. Rinse all surfaces that come in contact with food such as countertops, exteriors of appliances, tables and stovetops with potable water before reuse. Do not use on utensils, glassware and dishes.

For fungicidal activity: This product is an effective one-step fungicide against Trichophyton interdigitale when used on hard nonporous surfaces in areas such as locker rooms, dressing rooms, shower and bath areas and exercise facilities. Allow surface to remain visibly wet for 10 minutes.
