LITE AIDE® EMERGENCY FLOOD LIGHT WITH AUTOMATIC NIGHT LIGHT

Thank you for purchasing this Emergency Spotlight & Automatic Night Light from Universal Security Instruments. This manual includes important information regarding operation, maintenance and testing. **Be sure to read and follow all safety instructions.**

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

1. Servicing of this light should be performed by qualified personnel only. The product contains no serviceable parts. Refer to Warranty for detail
2. Do not use any other power adapter to charge the battery

FEATURES

- Energy Efficient Ultra-Bright White LED emergency light automatically turns on during power failure
- Photo sensor triggers the soft LED night light. Night light automatically turns on at dark, turns off at dawn
- Built-in rechargeable battery included
- Lower power consumption—long battery life
- Long-life, 6 LED array, with two separate flood lights
- 48 Hours of Continuous Emergency Flood Lighting
- 80 Hours of Continuous Night Lighting
- Red LED confirms light is charging

INSTALLATION

1. Adjust the swivel lighting heads up or down and left to right to direct light where needed.
2. The lighting head rotation is limited—**Figure 1**. Try not to extend beyond the angle shown; otherwise it may cause internal mechanical damage.
3. Mount the unit in desired area using the template attached below. Wall anchors and screws are included for your convenience. **Figure 2**.
4. Plug the power adaptor into an AC outlet and the power adaptor plug into the night light unit. The night light unit must be plugged into an AC outlet to charge the battery. Allow at least 48-72 hours for the internal 6VDC battery to fully charge to it's rated capacity before

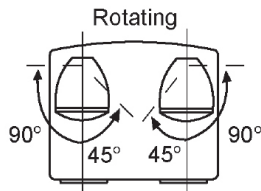

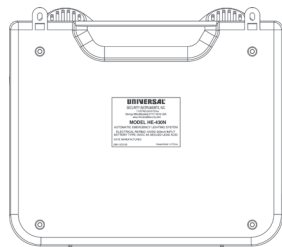
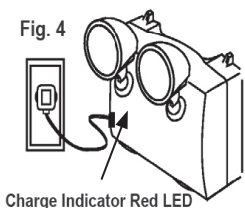

initial operation. **Figure 3.**

NOTE: The red LED charge indicator will stay lit when the unit is plugged into the AC power outlet.

OPERATION

NOTE: The on/off switch controls the emergency light only

1. Set the emergency light switch to one of the following:
 - 2 Lights—Both lights come on when power fails
 - 1 Light—One light comes on when power fails
 - Off—Both lights are off

During an electrical power failure:

- a. The lights will automatically come on and last for approximately 48 hours when the switch is set at 2 Lights
- b. The lights will automatically come on and last for approximately 96 hours when the switch is set at 1 Light

2. Set the night light switch to one of the following:
 - ON—To manually switch night light on
 - OFF—To manually switch night light off
 - AUTO—Soft LED night light automatically turns on at dark/dusk.

NOTE: Emergency light will provide 80 hours of continuous lighting for night light

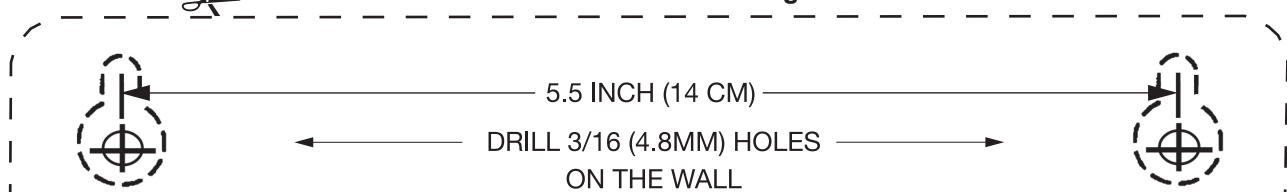
Soft LED night light automatically turns on at dark/dusk, or when household lighting is off. Night light automatically turns off at dawn, or when household lighting is on.

TESTING

1. Depress and hold the test button located on the front of the product. The power adaptor must be plugged into the light and the battery charged. One or two of the lights should turn on. When the button is released, the light(s) will turn off.
2. If the lights do not come on, try one or more of the following:
 - a. Unplug and reconnect the power adaptor plug into the light. The Red LED charging light should be on.
 - b. Confirm the AC outlet has power.
 - c. Press and hold the test button longer.

To reduce the risk of injury, only charge the light using the provided power adaptor. Other types of power adaptors may cause personal injury or damage.
